ORDINANCE NO. 1429

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING COURT COSTS IN WEIR MUNICIPAL COURT

AS AUTHORIZED BY CHARTER ORDINANCES 1132 AND 1133

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WEIR, CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS:

Section 1: Court Costs. Whenever a defendant in a case before the Municipal Court of the City of Weir, Kansas, is either convicted of violating a municipal ordinance or ordinances or enters into a diversion agreement concerning a violation thereof, said defendant shall be assessed court costs in the sum of Ninety-Five dollars (\$95.00), which costs shall be assessed in addition to any fine imposed by the Municipal Court for such violations.

Section 2. Exemptions. Cases in which the only conviction is for parking violations, other than parking within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant, or in front of a public or private driveway, or in a handicapped parking space, shall be exempted from the provisions of section 1 hereof.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. Ordinance No. 1391 of the City of Weir, Kansas is hereby repealed. All existing ordinances of the City of Weir, Kansas, are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
