A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE FOR REGULATION OF DRAINAGE DITCHES & CULVERTS WITHIN THE CITY OF WEIR.

WHEREAS: The Governing Body of the City of Weir, Kansas deems it necessary to establish a policy regarding regulation of drainage ditches and culverts within the City of Weir;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WEIR, KANSAS: The Governing Body of the City of Weir, Kansas establishes the following regulations regarding maintenance and upkeep of drainage ditches and culverts within the City of Weir.

Section 1. The purpose of this resolution is to encourage the flow and passage of water within the drainage ditches of Weir, Kansas and to prevent impediments and restrictions in said flow.

Section 2. Property/landowners are responsible for keeping their ditches and culverts free and clear of obstructions so as not to impede or restrict the drainage flow throughout town, or cause any neighboring property's drainage to be obstructed.


Section 3. All installations and replacements of whistles and tubes within the city limits of Weir, Kansas shall be approved in advance by the Weir City Council or its designee.

Section 4. All whistles or tubes installed or replaced within the city limits of Weir, Kansas shall be constructed of corrugated plastic or galvanized metal.

Section 5. All whistles and tubes installed or replaced shall have a diameter of not less than 12 inches. The minimum length for whistles and tubes installed or replaced shall be twenty (20) feet for single or double-vehicle driveways.

Section 6. All whistles and tubes installed or replaced shall be purchased by the property owner. The gravel and backfill for each whistle or tube installed or replaced shall be approved by the Weir City Council or its designee and purchased by the landowner. The installation and/or replacement of the whistle or tube shall be conducted by the City of Weir at no cost to the landowner.
